Privacy Policy
Effective as of January 26, 2016

Welcome to the web site (the "Site") of Wheelabrator Technologies Inc. and/or its affiliates (collectively "Wheelabrator", "we", "us" and/or "our"). This Site has been created to provide information about our company and to provide registered users with the ability to access and use services including our bill pay service (collectively, the "Service"). This Privacy Policy sets forth our policy with respect to information, including personally identifiable data ("Personal Data"), that is collected from visitors to our Site ("you," "your", and/or "user").

INFORMATION WE COLLECT. When you interact with us through our Site, we may collect Personal Data and other information from you, as further described below:

Personal Data That You Provide To Us: We collect Personal Data from you when you voluntarily provide such information, including but not limited to when you register with us to open an account to access and use our Service. You may be asked to choose a username and password for access to certain Services, and to provide various types of information, some of it relating to the governmental or corporate entity on behalf of which you will be our Services, some of it related to individuals who will be authorized users of the Services. The information you will be asked to provide in order to register for the Services, includes, without limitation:

- Your company's or municipality's name and contact information;
- The names, work phone numbers and work email addresses of your employees who will be using the Site and our Service; and
- Payment information (credit card details or bank account information to ACH transfers)

We also collect Personal Data and transactional information about bills and payment of those bills if and when you when you use that particular Service, including when you pay your bills through the Service.

By voluntarily providing us with Personal Data, you are consenting to our use of it in accordance with this Privacy Policy. If you provide Personal Data to us through the Site, you acknowledge and agree that such Personal Data may be transferred from your current location to the offices and servers of Wheelabrator and the authorized third parties referred to herein located in the United States and other third countries.

Although payment information is collected through the Site, it is never stored by Wheelabrator. All payment information entered through the Site is directly delivered to and is processed by a third party service provider.

Other Information

Non-Identifiable Data: When you interact with us through the Site, we receive and store certain personally non-identifiable information. Such information, which is collected passively using various technologies, cannot presently be used to specifically identify you. We may store such information or such information may be included in databases owned and maintained by third parties, including our Related Companies (as defined below) or service providers. We may use such information and pool it with other information to track, for example, the total number of visitors to our Site, the number of visitors to each page of our Site, the domain names of our visitors' Internet service providers and the use of our Site. The Site also automatically captures IP addresses. We use IP addresses to analyze trends, administer the Site, track user movement, ensure the security of your interaction with the Site and gather broad demographic information for aggregate use.

In operating the Site, we may also use cookies. Our cookies help provide additional functionality to the Site and help us analyze Site usage more accurately. On most web browsers, you will find a "help" section on the toolbar. Please refer to this section for information on how to receive notification when you are receiving a new cookie and how to turn cookies off. We recommend that you leave cookies turned on because they allow you to take advantage of some of the Site's features.

The Site uses Google Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google, Inc. ("**Google**"). Google Analytics uses cookies to help the Site analyze how users use the Site. The information generated by the cookie about your use of the Site (including your IP address) will be transmitted to and stored by Google on servers in the United States. Google will use this information for the purpose of evaluating your use of the Site, compiling reports on website

activity for website operators and providing other services relating to website activity and internet usage. Google may also transfer this information to third parties where required to do so by law, or where such third parties process the information on Google's behalf. As noted above, on most web browsers you may refuse the use of cookies by selecting the appropriate settings, however please note that if you do this you may not be able to use the full functionality of the Site. By using the Site, you consent to the processing of data about you by Google in the manner and for the purposes set out above.

Managing Cookies and Do Not Track: We do not currently respond to browser "do not track" signals on our Site or Services. You can change the way your browser handles cookies. Already existing cookies can be deleted. Please consult www.allaboutcookies.org on how to manage or delete cookies in your browser.

OUR USE OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA AND OTHER INFORMATION. We use the Personal Data you provide in a manner that is consistent with this Privacy Policy. If you provide Personal Data for a certain reason, we may use the Personal Data in connection with the reason for which it was provided. For instance, if you provide Personal Data, including to register for our Services, we will use the information to provide you with access to and use of the Services.

Wheelabrator and its subsidiaries and affiliates (the "Related Companies") may also use your Personal Data as well as personally non-identifiable information collected through the Site to help us improve the content and functionality of the Site and to better understand our users. In an ongoing effort to better understand and serve the users of our Site, we may conduct research on its customer demographics, interests and behavior based on the Personal Data and other information provided to us. This research may be compiled and analyzed on an aggregate basis, and we may share this aggregate data with various third parties.

Wheelabrator and its Related Companies may use your Personal Data to contact you in the future to tell you about services we believe will be of interest to you. If we do so, each communication we send you will contain instructions permitting you to "opt-out" of receiving future communications. In addition, if at any time you wish not to receive any future communications or you wish to have your name deleted from our mailing lists, please contact us as indicated below.**OUR DISCLOSURE OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA AND OTHER INFORMATION.** We are not in the business of selling your Personal Data. We consider this information to be a vital part of our relationship with you. There are, however, certain circumstances in which we may share your Personal Data with certain third parties without further notice to you, as set forth below:

Business Transfers. As we develop our business, we might sell or buy businesses or assets. In the event of a corporate sale, merger, reorganization, dissolution or similar event, Personal Data may be part of the transferred assets.**Related Companies:** We may share your Personal Data with our Related Companies for purposes consistent with this Privacy Policy.**Service Providers:** We may engage other companies to perform certain business-related functions, such as maintaining our databases. When we employ another company to perform a function of this nature, we only provide them with the information that they need to perform their specific function and require them to maintain the confidentiality of our user data.**Legal Requirements:** We may disclose your Personal Data if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to (i) comply with a legal obligation, (ii) protect and defend the rights or property of [Company] or other third parties, (iii) act in urgent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of the Site or any third party, or (iv) protect against legal liability. **YOUR CHOICES.** You can visit our Site and view information displayed publicly on the Site without providing any Personal Data.

CHILDREN. The Site is not designed for or intended to be used by children. We do not knowingly collect Personal Data from children under the age of 13. If you are under the age of 13, please do not submit any Personal Data to us through the Site.

THIRD PARTY SITES. This Privacy Policy applies only to the Site. The Site may contain links to or otherwise interact with other web sites not operated or controlled by us (the "Third Party Sites"). The policies and procedures we described here do not apply to the Third Party Sites. We suggest contacting those third parties directly for information on their privacy policies.

SECURITY. We take reasonable steps to protect the Personal Data provided via the Site from loss, misuse, and unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction. However, no Internet or e-mail transmission is ever fully secure or error free. In particular, e-mail or messages sent to or from the Site may not be secure. Therefore, you should take special care in deciding what information you send to us.

CHANGES TO OUR PRIVACY POLICY. The Site and our business may change from time to time. As a result, at times it may be necessary for us to make changes to this Privacy Policy. We reserve the right to update or modify

this Privacy Policy at any time and from time to time without prior notice. Please review this policy periodically, and especially before you provide any Personal Data. This Privacy Policy was last updated on the date indicated above. Your continued use of the Site after any changes or revisions to this Privacy Policy shall indicate your agreement with the terms of such revised Privacy Policy.
